***Director of the Independent Office of Law
Enforcement Review & Outreach (IOLERO)***

In March 2016, Jerry Threet, a licensed attorney since 1988, was unanimously selected by the Sonoma County Board of Supervisors to be the first Director of the new Independent Office of Law Enforcement Review and Outreach also known as IOLERO. Its charge is to conduct independent reviews of investigations alleging law enforcement misconduct, including excessive use of force, and to engage the community in the review and possible recommendation of policy changes to the Sheriff's Office and the Board of Supervisors. In addition to developing a new office, Mr. Threet, along with the Community Advisory Council and Sheriff's Department staff, developed policy recommendations concerning the department's cooperation with ICE. This year the policies concerning use of force are being reviewed. Mr. Threet will speak about the ongoing work of this important new agency.
