****California Democratic Party Assembly District 2 and 10 Delegate Elections**

The Democratic State Central Committee AKA the California Democratic Party reorganizes its delegation in odd years. In 2019 the Assembly District Election Meetings (ADEM) will take place in Sonoma County.

The filing to run as a delegate to the DSCC is now open, and will close in Assembly District 2 on December 12, 2018 at 5pm. The filing to run for Assembly District delegate in AD 10 will close on December 26, 2018 at 5 pm.

If you are a registered Democrat as of 10/22/2018 and live in Assembly District 2 or 10, you can apply to run in the Assembly District Election. Please go to the California Democratic Party website at www.cadem.org and look for ADEM filing, it is on the front page.

Information for AD2:

The election in AD 2 will take place on Saturday January 12, 2019 at the Odd Fellows Hall, 545 Pacific Ave in Santa Rosa. Doors open at 10 am, candidate speeches start at 10:30 am and voting begins at 11 am until 1 pm. Voting closes at 1 pm (if you are in-line at 1 pm, you will receive a ballot). Any registered Democrat living in Assembly District 2 (James Wood) can receive a ballot, or you can register as a Democrat at the election on 1/12/19 and receive a ballot.

Information for AD10:

The election in AD 10 (Marc Levine) is on Saturday January 26, 2019 at the Plumber's Hall, 3473 Santa Rosa Avenue in Santa Rosa. Doors open and speeches begin at 10 am, and voting starts at 10:30 am until 12:30 pm. Same as above for voting, you must live in AD 10, and be a registered democrat (same day registration is allowed).
