### **To Assist our Seniors related to Grocery Shopping, we offer the following information.**

#### **Oliver's (all Sonoma County Stores)**

- Starting 3/19, 6 am to 7 am everyday will be dedicated to providing seniors (those 60 and over) with a safe and less crowded shopping experience.
- The 10% discount for seniors will be given every Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday from 6 am to 4 pm each week until April 30th.

#### **Target (all stores)**

- Reducing hours and will close all stores by 9 pm daily in order to replenish and deeply clean stores. Stores hours will be from 8 am to 9 pm daily.
- The first hour of shopping each Wednesday will be reserved for vulnerable guests including the elderly and those with underlying health conditions.

#### **Raley's (all stores)**

- Store hours seem to be the same; 6 am to 11 pm every day.
- Starting 3/19, Raley's will offer curbside pickup for prescriptions at their pharmacy locations. You need to contact the local pharmacy team via phone to make this request and schedule a pickup. This service is reserved for at-risk and senior patients. Raley's is unable to coordinate grocery and prescription pickup together.
- Starting 3/21, Raley's will have two unique Senior Essential Bags available for purchase at a discounted price. The bags can be picked up daily, curbside, or in-store. There are two bags available; one for \$20 and one for \$35. These bags are reserved for at-risk and seniors only. Check the website for details on contents of the bags.

#### **Whole Foods (both Coddington Mall & Yulupa Avenue stores)**

- Store hours are from 9 am to 8 pm daily.
- Seniors 60 and older may shop one hour before opening to the public (8 am to 9 am)
- All hot and cold bars are closed as are taprooms.
- Limited to no seating in eating areas.

### **Safeway**

- Store hours currently remain the same.
- From 7 am to 9 am every Tuesday and Thursday, senior citizens, pregnant women, people with compromised immune systems may shop during these two hours before the store opens to the general public.

### **WalMart**

- Store hours will be from 7 am to 8:30 pm.
- Every Tuesday beginning 3/24 through 4/28/2020, senior citizens age 60 and older may shop for one hour before regular retail hours.
- Pharmacy and vision services will be available during the one hour shopping time on Tuesdays for senior citizens.

### **Trader Joe's (both Santa Rosa locations)**

- Store hours will be from 9 am to 7 pm.
- Suspending all sample tasting.
- No special times for seniors because the CDC recommends people stay home.

### **Lucky's**

- Store hours will be from 6 am to 10 pm.
- Starting Tuesday, March 24th, every Tuesday and Thursday, all Lucky's stores will open between 6 am and 9 am for seniors pregnant women, and guests with compromised health needs.

### **Lola's**

- Store hours remain the same, 7 am to 10 pm.
- No notification of any special shopping hours for seniors or people at risk.

### **Food Maxx**

- Store hours remain the same 6 am to 2 am.
- Starting Tuesday, March 24th, every Tuesday and Thursday, all Food Maxx stores will open between 6 am and 9 am for seniors, pregnant women, and guests with compromised health needs.

### **Community Market**

- Store hours Santa Rosa Monday thru Friday 8 am to 8 pm, Sat & Sunday 9 am to 8 pm
- The Market will limit the number of people in their stores.
- Personal shopping and curbside services will be available by phone.

### **Andy's Produce**

- Store hours 8 am to 7:30 pm daily.
- Encourage people to order takeout from our local restaurants and cafes.
