

## *CDP Assembly District Delegates Election*

Every two years California Democratic Party (CDP) elects delegates to the CDP Central Committee. These delegates are elected from the 80 CA Assembly Districts, and the next election is in January 2021. This is your opportunity to represent your Assembly District for the 2021-2022 term. And, if not interested in representing your Assembly District, you may vote for those delegates to represent you. In order to qualify as an ADEM delegate or to vote, you must live in either Assembly District 2 or Assembly District 5, and be a registered Democrat.

In order to participate as either a delegate or to vote for the delegates from your Assembly District, the information follows. Because of COVID-19, there will be no in-person elections, and all elections will be held virtually with voting completed by mail. For more information, please visit <https://adem.cadem.org/>.

**Role of Delegates:** Together CADEM Delegates vote and conduct party business at the yearly State Convention and Executive Board meetings including:

- Election of CDP Officers: Chairman, two Vice-Chairs, Secretary and Controller (in odd-numbered years after presidential elections)
- Election of 16-25 Regional Directors who function as liaisons between the California Democratic Party, County Central Committees, and Democratic Clubs in regions comprised of 3 to 5 Assembly Districts (in odd-numbered years)
- Vote for the Endorsements of the California Democratic Party for partisan legislative and statewide offices in California

**To run as an ADEM Candidate,** click here <https://ademelections.com/?isCandidate=True>. The deadline to apply is December 15, 2020. If you register as an ADEM Candidate, you do not have to register to vote. You are automatically registered to vote by applying to be a candidate.

**In order to vote for ADEM Candidates, you must register** by clicking here <https://ademelections.com/?isCandidate=False>. Deadline to register is January 11, 2021. In 2021, there will be no in person meetings to elect our ADEM Delegates. All voting will be done by mail, and that is why you must register with CDP to vote.

Again, in order to **RUN** as an **ADEM Candidate** and/or **VOTE** for your **ADEM Candidates**, you must be a registered Democrat and live in either Assembly District 2 (represented by Jim Wood) or Assembly District 10 (represented by Marc Levine).
