Elected to the Santa Rosa City Council in November of 2016, Chris was elected Vice Mayor for 2018. He serves on the following committees: Santa Rosa's Build and Rebuild subcommittee, Joint City-County post-fire recovery ad hoc committee, Long-term Financial Policy and Audit committee, Cannabis committee, Sonoma Clean Power, Mayors and Councilmembers legislative task force, League of Cities Environmental Quality committee.
