Professor Andy Merrifield

Sonoma State Political Science Professor

This month's speaker is Sonoma State University Professor Emeritus Andy Merrifield. Andy received his PhD in Political Science from UC Davis in 1992. He joined the SSU faculty as a Lecturer in 1987 and accepted a tenure track position in the Political Science Department in 1996, and retired after 30 years in May 2017. Andy also served on the bargaining team and was President of the Sonoma State University Chapter of the California Faculty Association for many years.

He has provided analysis on elections, policy making and public institutions for local, regional, state and national media and was often quoted in the Press Democrat prior to his retirement. He will be sharing his insights on the modern American politics and how personal behavior and relationships can impact policy success.
