Dorothy Battenfeld, elected to the Santa Rosa Junior College Board of Trustees in 2014, currently serves as Board President. She is also on the California Community College Advisory Committee on Legislation and on the Affordability, Food and Housing Access Taskforce. She chairs the Santa Rosa Board of Trustees Finance Committee and is a member of the Scholarship Committee. She is also a member of a recently formed Committee on Racial Justice. In addition to her SRJC work, Dorothy has experience serving on boards and leadership committees at the national, state and local level for a variety of education, social service and civic organizations.

A Social Science teacher at Montgomery High School in Santa Rosa for 30 years, Dorothy coordinated Montgomery's highly regarded International Baccalaureate Diploma Program, which she helped to found in 1995. A Q & A will follow her presentation.
